Affected charges have the full text cropped and end with the text ",end of text For further information contact the originating authority"	Before: Enforcement Notice dated 12th July 2013 in respect of:- Land to the south of Elmhaven Marina and lying to the east of Rochester road, Wouldham Requiring:- i) Cease the use of the Land for private amenity and recreational purposes ii) Cease the use of the Land for storage of timber, domestic paraphernalia and waste items iii) Remove all items stored on the Land including timber, domestic paraphernalia and waste items stored form the Land iv) Remove the shed, storage boxes, log mooring structures, bridge and gate feature from the Land i) Remove all hardstanding and pathways form the Land and restore that part of the Land by spreading a minimum of 150mm clean topsoilover it and seeding it with a wild grass seed mix v) Remove the pond liner from the Land and fill the pond with topsoil to a level that it is consistent with the adjacent land vi) Following completion of steps (i) -(v) above remove all resultant materials to an authorised waste tip unless some other depository has been previously agreed in wirting by the Local Planning Authority vii) Restore the Land to its condition prior to the commencement of the unauthorised uses and operational development leaving the Land clear from man made structures or items save that water borne vessels used for recreation on the River Medway may be moored between high and low water marks by means of an anchor. Period for compliance - Within six weeks from the date this notice takes effect. Notice effective from:- 14th August 2013 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.
