

In line with the English Quota Management Rules, the MMO reserves the right to require that a vessel's licence brings with it FQA units appropriate to the planned fishing area and gear, or equivalent to the English non-sector catch limits in the previous full quota year. Quota Managers will use the information provided below, plus any additional evidence supplied, along with historical landings for the vessel to assess entry into the English non-sector.

To determine if FQA units are required please fill in the table below providing a monthly breakdown of the species to be targeted including alternatives if necessary, in which sea area, with what gear, where the stocks are to be landed and an estimate of landings.
