The judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that the respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages of £1,336.00 (gross) in respect of unpaid car allowance and £18,025.13 (gross) in respect of unpaid commission.

The sums awarded are expressed gross of tax and national insurance, the respondent shall pay to the claimant the net sum due in respect of both sums to the claimant. It is for the respondent to make any deductions lawfully required to account to HMRC for any tax and employees' national insurance due on these sums, if applicable.
