This letter confirms the amount of delegated Adult Education Budget (AEB) you will receive in the financial year (FY) 2024-25 (1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025) to deliver relevant adult education functions in your delegated area.

We are providing this grant as a non-ring-fenced transfer under Section 39A of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and have copied this grant letter to the Chief Finance Officer of the Greater London Authority for information.
