Converter Academy Orders

Points discussed in relation to school conversion.

Project: To discuss the application from St Bonaventure's Catholic Primary School, Bristol to convert and become an academy and join The Cardinal Newman Catholic Educational Trust.

Representations received:

• No representations were made for this project.

Points raised in Discussion: ** all projects for The Cardinal Newman Catholic Educational Trust were discussed together.

- St Bonaventure's is a two-form entry primary school, which received a Good Ofsted judgement in June 2023. This is a voluntary conversion.
- St Joseph's is a single form entry primary school, which received a Good Ofsted judgement December 2021. This is a voluntary conversion.
- St Patrick's is a single form entry academy that converted to academy status in 2012. The school was graded outstanding at its Ofsted inspection in 2013. This is a voluntary transfer.
- The Academy strategy for the Clifton Diocese was discussed, the Bishop's vision is for all Catholic schools to join a multi-academy trust.
- The Cardinal Newman Catholic Educational Trust (Newman) is a MAT in the Clifton Diocese that opened in March 2022. It currently has four schools, three in Bristol and one in North Somerset.
- The diversity of the trust board and educational expertise at primary was discussed. Regions Group will review this with the trust.
- The financial position of the trust was discussed, and Regions Group will liaise with the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) and the trust.
- It was recommended that the trust considers a review of the central trust functions and how to develop their offer in line with trust growth.

Establishing a new academy through the free school presumption route

Project: To discuss the proposed sponsor for a new presumption primary free school proposal at Weston Runway, Weston-super-Mare, **North Somerset**.

- North Somerset Council has identified a need to establish a new 630 place primary school, with an attached nursery. Weston-Super-Mare has seen a period of rapid housing growth in the Weston Airfield development area.
- The LA's preferred trust is Cabot Learning Federation (CLF).
- CLF have the experience, capability, and depth of knowledge to be able to deliver and run the school. CLF understand the local area and has a dedicated and experienced free school team in place, they have opened two free schools within North Somerset.
- The Council, with input from Regions Group, assessed the applicants and CLF was the strongest candidate across all areas.
