JUDGMENT

The Employment Judge gave Judgment as follows:

- 1. The name of the Respondent is amended to Mr Nikolas Alex Constantinou trading as Sea and Earth Chip Shop.
- 2. The claims of age discrimination and sex discrimination are withdrawn and dismissed.
- 3. The Claimant has suffered an unlawful deduction of wages and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £576.80 gross.
- 4. The Respondent has failed to pay to the Claimant his holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £1,064.
- 5. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the Claimant of £190.
- 6. The Respondent has failed to provide the Claimant with a statement of terms and conditions of employment contrary to Section 1 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £380.

7. The total sum of compensation payable by the Respondent to the Claimant is $\pounds 2,210.80$.
