

Kept Bird Registration Form - Keeper of less than 50 Poultry or Other Captive Birds

If you keep any number of birds at any premises, you are required by law to register the birds and the location where they are kept. Use this form to register each site where you keep 49 or less poultry or other captive birds, even if you keep them as pets or register via the <u>online service</u>. You must do this within one month of keeping bird(s). You are breaking the law if you do not register.

Complete this form if you are in charge of the day-to-day care of the birds (**the keeper**). Complete all fields marked with an * or add 'N/A'. Contact the Customer Registration Team on **03000 200 301** for help with completing the form.

If you keep 50 poultry or more birds, you must fill in either the **Kept Bird Registration Form** - **Keeper of 50 or More Poultry** or **Kept Bird Registration Form** - **Keeper of 50 or More Other Captive Birds**. Both forms are available on <u>GOV.UK</u>. You are breaking the law if you do not register.

Note:

- "other captive bird" means any bird kept in captivity which is not poultry and includes a pet bird and any bird kept for shows, races, exhibitions, competitions, breeding or for sale.
- "poultry" means all birds that are reared or kept in captivity for the production of meat or eggs for consumption, the production of other commercial products, for restocking supplies of game or for the purposes of any breeding programme for the production of these categories of birds.
- "keeper" means the person with day-to-day responsibility for poultry or other captive birds at any premises.
- "occupier" means, in relation to any premises, the person in charge of those premises.
