

Kept Bird Registration Form - Keeper of 50 or More Other Captive Birds

If you keep any number of birds at any premises, you are required by law to register the birds and the location where they are kept. Use this form to register each site where you keep flocks of 50 or more other captive birds. You must do this within one month of keeping them. You are breaking the law if you do not register.

You must complete this form if you are in charge of the day-to-day care of the birds (the keeper).

You must complete all fields marked with an * or add 'N/A' as appropriate. Contact the Customer Registration Team on **03000 200 301** for help with completing the form

If you keep 50 or more poultry you will need to complete the **Kept Bird Registration Form - Keeper of 50 or More Poultry** available on GOV.UK.

If you keep fewer than 50 poultry or other captive birds you can register your flocks by using the <u>online service</u> available on GOV.UK or by completing the **Kept Bird Registration Form - less than 50 Poultry or Other Captive Birds** available on GOV.UK.

You are breaking the law if you do not register.

Note:

- "other captive bird" means any bird kept in captivity which is not poultry and includes a pet bird and any bird kept for shows, races, exhibitions, competitions, breeding or for sale.
- "poultry" means all birds that are reared or kept in captivity for the production of meat or eggs for
 consumption, the production of other commercial products, for restocking supplies of game or for
 the purposes of any breeding programme for the production of these categories of birds.
- "**keeper**" means the person with day-to-day responsibility for poultry or other captive birds at any premises.
- "occupier" means, in relation to any premises, the person in charge of those premises.
