The sample was found to contain between 1008-1480mg/kg (<math>244 \pm 236</math>mg/kg) of migratable boron, which exceeds the maximum permissible concentration of 300mg/kg. Digestion or contact with an excessive quantity of boron may harm the health of children by damaging their reproductive system.</p> <p>The product does not meet the requirements of the Toys (Safety) Regulations 2011.</p> |
