I hope you have both seen the draft permit. All permits will now come through our new system RESP if the email address confused you.

You will notice that WEEE storage and treatment condition have been reduced. This is because they are considered to be covered already by appropriate measures. However in your Operating Techniques you need to quote that you work in line with appropriate measures and particularly concentrate on ensuring you are compliant with those areas where you have said that you are not compliant in your Reg 61 response. Part of this is enclosure of the shredder etc which you have already said you are going to . It just needs updating on the Operating techniques.

Once done I can then reference appropriate measures in the permit and we probably don't need a pre op condition on this. If you could ideally do this by 21st October that would be great. If you are struggling please let me know.

As I have said to Clare if you do have any questions we will set up a teams call with E & B to discuss why we have put these conditions in.
