MPs' induction sessions

The Chair reported that he took part in two days of induction sessions for new MPs. The panel also included the Parliamentary Commissioner for Standards; IPSA; ICGS and the Electoral Commission. A further induction session was also being arranged.

The Chair said that it was clear that intimidation of candidates had been a serious problem during the campaign period.

Comms and media interest

The Chair highlighted the blog published on 8 July about setting standards, welcoming the new government's clear commitment to high standards in their election manifesto and the Prime Minister's statements, and highlighting the Principles of Public Life.

A number of media requests had been turned down during the pre- election period of sensitivity.

Meeting with Chairs of Independent (standards) Offices

The Chair reported that he would be chairing one of his regular, informal meetings with the Chairs of Independent Offices on 24 July.

Visit by Japanese Delegation

It was noted that Professor Gillian Peele would represent the Committee at a meeting with a delegation from Japan's House of Representatives to discuss the role and work of the Committee. The meeting was at the request of the Japanese Embassy.
