Significant changes

Project: Wigmore Primary School, Wigmore School Academy Trust
Herefordshire - to lower the age of the nursery provision in place from 3 years to 2 years.

Decision: Approve.

Further action required: No action required.

Project: Oak Wood Secondary School, Central England Academy Trust,
Warwickshire - acquiring of a satellite site.

Decision: Approve.

Project: All Saints CE Primary School, Staffordshire University Academy Trust,
Staffordshire - to change the age range from 3-11 to 2-11, to extend the nursery provision from 3-4 years old to 2-4 years old, with provision for 14-22 places.

Project: St Thomas' Church of England Primary Academy, Manor Multi Academy Trust, Wolverhampton - reduction in age range from 5 to 11 to 3 to 11, which would allow for the provision of onsite nursery provision.

Project: Ellesmere Primary School, North West Academies Trust Limited, Shropshire - to add a Resource Base (RB) with a maximum intake of 12 pupils with effect from September 2024.
