The Primary Medical Services (Directed Enhanced Services) (Amendment) Directions 2024

The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 98A(3), 272(7) and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a), gives the following Directions.

Citation, commencement, extent and interpretation.

- 1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Primary Medical Services (Directed Enhanced Services) (Amendment) Directions 2024 and come into force on 1st October 2024.
 - (2) These Directions are given to NHS England (b).
 - (3) These Directions extend to England and Wales.
- (4) In these Directions, "the Principal Directions" means the Primary Medical Services (Directed Enhanced Services) Directions 2024.

Amendment to the Principal Directions

- **2.**—(1) The Principal Directions are amended as follows.
- (2) In Direction 4 (Network Directed Enhanced Service Scheme)—
