






# Adding a website shortcut to your home screen (Android)

1. On your Android device, open Chrome  (or any other browser you like to use).
2. Go to the website you want to create a shortcut for - <https://record-catch.service.gov.uk/sign-in>.
3. To the right of the address bar, tap More  and then tap **Add to home screen**.
4. Next tap **Create shortcut**.
5. From the dialog that appears:
  - Rename: Select the default name for the shortcut or rename the shortcut.
6. Tap **Add**.

*Tip: Shortcuts with Chrome logo will open in Chrome.*

# Adding a website shortcut to your home screen (iPhone)

1. Go to the Safari app  on your iPhone.
2. Go to the website you want to add to your Home Screen - <https://record-catch.service.gov.uk/sign-in>.
3. Tap the Share  button in the menu bar.
4. Scroll down the list of options, then tap **Add to Home Screen**.
  - If you don't see **Add to Home Screen**, you can add it. Scroll down to the bottom of the list, tap **Edit Actions**, then tap  **Add to Home Screen**.

*Tip: The icon appears only on the device where you add it.*
