Re: Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request

Thank you for your email of 19 June 2024 in which you requested from the Insolvency Service (the agency):

"I would like to understand how a particular award was made within the current procurement regime.

On 27 April 2021, a notice was published on Contracts Finder of a procurement made by the Insolvency Service. The Total Value of the contract is £304,000. The procedure type used for this award is stated to be 'Single tender action (below threshold)'. However, my understanding is that the threshold for the application of one of the five procurement procedures under the PCR 2015 is £139,688 for Central Government bodies and £214,904 for other contracting authorities.

Please could you explain what procurement procedure was used to make this award and the basis for that procedure in the rules?
