

II. Health information

I, the undersigned official veterinarian certify that

- **II.1.1** the captive bird(s)¹ described in this certificate come from the zone with Code² which, at the date of issue of the certificate, is authorised and listed in Part 1 of Annex VI to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/404 for entry into the Union of captive birds.
- **II.1.2** The animals are moved for the purpose of a conservation programme approved by the Competent Authority of the Country of destination.
- **II.1.3** Animals come from the confined establishment indicated in Box I.11 approved by the Competent Authority of the country or territory of origin in accordance with requirements which are at least as stringent as those laid down in Article 97 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2016/429 and:
 - (a) The approval of which has not been suspended or withdrawn.
 - (b) Which was not subject to national restriction measures for animal health reasons including for highly pathogenic ayian influenza (HPAI) or Newcastle's Disease virus (ND) [Annex I to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/692 relevant for the species and emerging diseases, at the time of dispatch of the animals to the Union]
 - (c) Within a 10km radius of which, including where appropriate, the territory of a neighbouring country, there has been no outbreak of HPAI or infection with ND for at least 30 days prior to the date of loading for dispatch to Northern Ireland
 - (d) For psittacidae only³, in which
- either [avian chlamydiosis has not been confirmed for a period of at least 6 months prior to the date of loading of the captive birds for dispatch to Northern Ireland;]
- or [avian chlamydiosis has been confirmed during the last 6 months prior to the date of loading of the captive birds for dispatch to Northern Ireland, but not during the last 60 days and the measures provided for in Article 55(i) of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/692 have been applied;]
- or [the animals have been kept under veterinary supervision for the 45 days prior to the date of loading for dispatch to Ireland and were treated against ayian chlamydiosis;]
- **II.2** Have been examined on (dd/mm/yyyy), within the 24 hours prior to loading for dispatch to the Union, and found to be free of clinical signs of infectious diseases, including the listed diseases referred to in Annex I(1) to the Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/692 relevant for the species and emerging diseases;

II.2.1 the captive bird(s);

- (a) have remained in the establishment indicated in Box I.11 since hatching or for a continuous period of at least 21 days prior to the date of loading for dispatch to Northern Ireland
- (b) have not been vaccinated against HPAI
- (c) during the 21 days immediately prior to loading for dispatch to Northern Ireland have remained in isolation in officially approved facilities, under the control of the competent authority.
- (d) have been subjected to a virus detection test⁴ for highly pathogenic avian influenza and infection with Newcastle disease virus with negative results within the period of 7 to 14 days prior to the date of loading for dispatch to Northern Ireland (laboratory test report must be attached)
- (e) Their movement has been authorised in advance by a written agreement of the competent authority of destination.
- **II.2.2** Arrangements have been made to ensure the animal(s) will be transported to Northern Ireland in compliance with Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005 or of recognised international standards for transport of animals, in particular as regards watering, feeding and the use of the transport container where applicable and

it/they is/are fit for the intended transport. A correctly authorised transporter will be used to transport this/these animals to Northern Ireland in a means of transport: -

- (a) constructed in such a way that the birds cannot escape or fall out, visual inspection of the space where the bird(s) is kept is possible, the escape of animal excrements, litter, feed, or feathers is prevented or minimised.
- (b) which contains only captive birds of the same species coming from the same establishment
- (c) where any containers in which the animals are transported are either:
 - (i) unused and purpose-designed disposable containers to be destroyed after first use⁵;

or

- (ii) cleaned and disinfected and dried or allowed to dry before loading of animals intended for entry into the Union⁵.
- (d) are closed in accordance with the instructions of the competent authority of the country or territory of origin to avoid any possibility of substitution of the content
- (e) bear the following information
 - (i) name and ISO code of the third country or territory of origin
 - (ii) the number of animals
 - (iii) the name, address, and approval number of the establishment of origin
 - (iv) the specific identification number of the container

- Box I.120 Pre-completed as this certificate only relates to captive birds for conservation programmes that are travelling to a confined establishment.
- Box 1.27 "Identification system": The animal must be individually identified by means of a unique marked closed leg-ring or an injectable transponder with either the three digit country code (826- for GB) or the 2 letter country code in accordance with Article 53 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/692. A clear link between the live animals and the health certificate must be established. CITES requirements may indicate the type of identification required.

- ⁴ The clinical inspection at II.2.1 (d) must have been carried out by an official veterinarian of the country of territory of origin. Tests should be carried out on samples taken by, or under the control of the competent authority of the country or territory of origin and testing should be carried out in an official laboratory, designated in accordance with Article 37 of Regulation (EU) 2017/625.
