Respondent: Virgin Atlantic Airways Limited

JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the basis that it has not been actively pursued.

REASONS

1. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 2 August 2022, asking her to confirm whether the claim was being pursued by 23 August 2022. No response was received.
2. On 2 August 2022 the respondent wrote to the Tribunal to confirm that the claimant had not responded to emails sent in November 2021. The claimant was copied into that correspondence.
3. On 18 October 2022, Employment Judge Dyal wrote to the claimant to ask her to confirm whether or not she wished to pursue her claim within 14 days and warned her, that if she did not respond, her claim was likely to be struck out.
4. There has been no response from the claimant, or any communication.
