JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The claim was issued in the London Central Employment Tribunal on 14 January 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages during the period 23 October 2023 to 12 November 2023, which includes a fully worked notice period, a total of 78.72 hours at £15.50 per hour and must pay the claimant £1,220.16 gross.
3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement in respect of 83.26 hours at £15.50 per hour and must pay the claimant £1,290.53 gross.
4. No deductions are required in respect of benefits received as the entire sums claimed were owed for periods worked and holidays accrued as at the date of termination.
5. The respondent must pay the claimant **£2510.69 gross** in total.
