

It's the time of year when the night sky is lit up by fireworks. But if they are not used safely, people and animals could be badly injured.

## Which fireworks can I use at home?

Before buying fireworks, check you have enough space in your garden to use them. You can find the category of the firework and the safety distance for spectators on the firework box.

- The minimum safety distance is at least **1 metre** unless otherwise specified.
- The minimum safety distance is at least 8 metres unless otherwise specified.
- The minimum spectator distance is **at least 25 metres** unless otherwise specified.

These are minimum safety distances only and specific fireworks may require more space. Check the fireworks box to be sure you have enough space to safely use a firework before you buy it.





## **Dispose of fireworks safely**



Ensure that the fireworks are out.



Soak them in water overnight.



Put them in a bag and in the bin.
