JUDGMENT

- 1) The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £2245.64 net.
- The claimant's complaint of breach of the Working Time Regulations (holiday pay is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £410.95 net.
