

APPLICATION FROM “J” VISA HOLDER
SEEKING A WAIVER OF THE TWO YEAR HOME RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT

1. I have applied to the United States Immigration authorities for permanent residence status in the United States.
2. I was admitted to the United States on a J1 Exchange Visitor’s Visa and my studies here have been subsidised from United States/United Kingdom Government funds. The United States authorities are accordingly unable to consider my application unless the United Kingdom Government are prepared to furnish the United States Secretary of State with a statement in writing that they have no objection to the grant of a waiver of the two year home residence requirement specified in Section 212(e) of the United States Immigration and Nationality Act (as amended).
3. I therefore request that the required statement be forwarded to the Department of State on my behalf
