JUDGMENT

The unanimous Judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The complaint of harassment related to age contrary to section 26 of the Equality Act 2010 is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of direct age discrimination contrary to section 13 of the Equality Act 2010 is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of been subjected to detriment for making a protected disclosure contrary to section 48 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The complaint of automatic unfair dismissal for making a protected disclosure contrary to section 103A of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is not well-founded and is dismissed.
