## JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 12 April 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant **£4,069.37**.
- 3. The respondent has failed to provide itemised pay statements and written terms and conditions in accordance with section 1 of the ERA 1996 and must pay the claimant £1,432.
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant **£2,227.40**.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £7,728.77 in total.
- 6. The claimant has withdrawn claims for discrimination on the grounds of race in the email dated 30 September 2024. This claim is therefore withdrawn.
- 7. The hearing listed on **23 January 2025 i**s cancelled.
