Thank you for your emails of 27 March 2024 and 20 May 2024 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"Pursuant to the FOI Act, I would be grateful for advice on the full MEDAL ENTITLEMENT of Major (Technical Instructor in Gunnery) James Sawford, Royal Artillery (285609).

Major Sawford was born on 10 June 1921, and served in the Royal Artillery from 1936 to 1969. He died on 27 March 1979 - more than 25 years ago. As Major Sawford retired on retired pay, I understand that you have access to his date of death, recorded on his file, and therefore you shouldn't need a copy of his death certificate."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). I am sorry for the length of time it has taken to reply.

A search of the Department has now been conducted and I can confirm that all information in scope of the request is held and provided below.

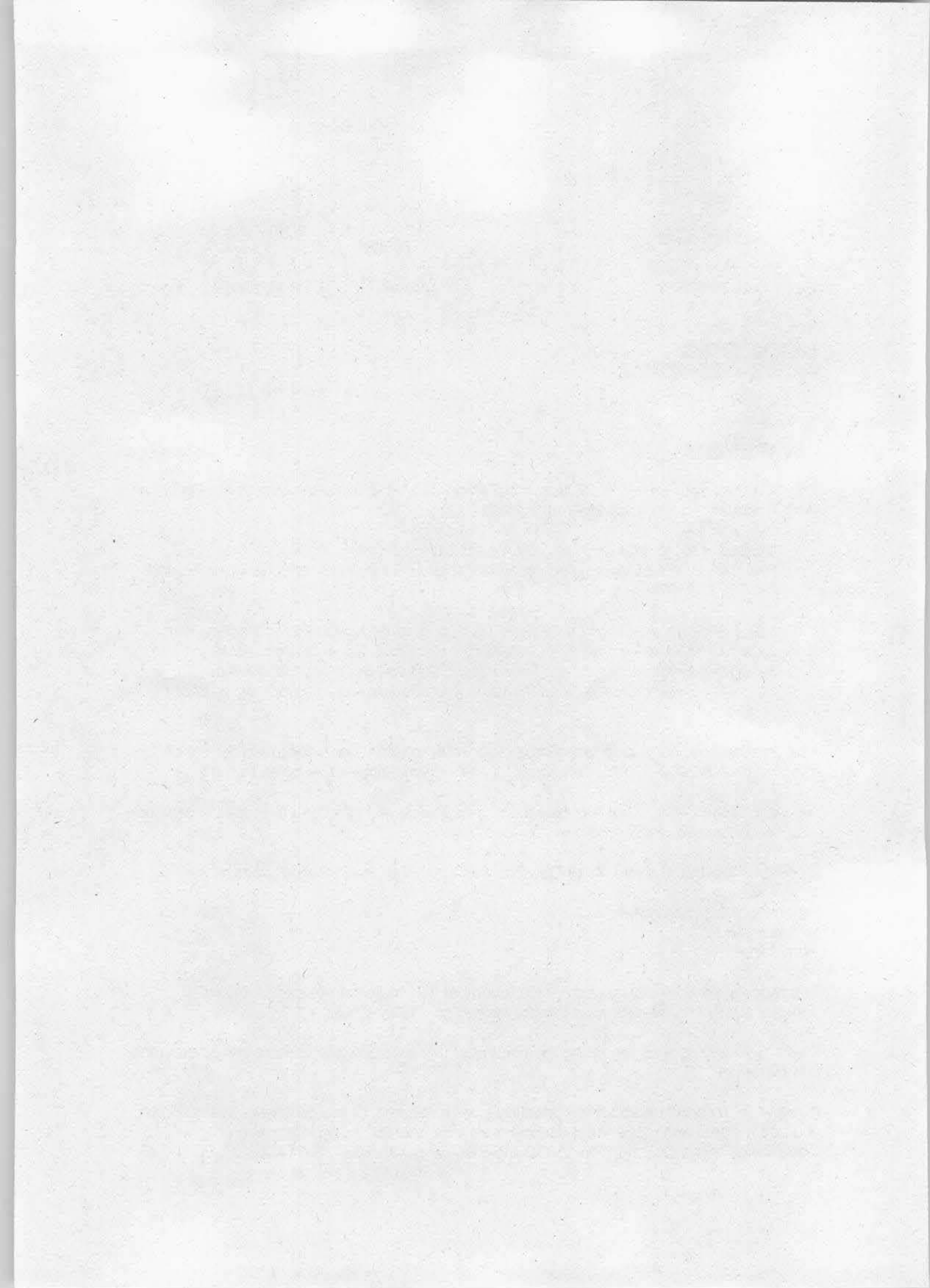
Records show that the late Major Sawford was entitled to the following medals:

France and Germany Star
Defence Medal
War Medal

The medals were initially issued on 30 November 1948 and returned to stock on 28 January 1949. The medals were then re-issued on 11 December 1959.
