[%] provides shareable wireless infrastructure across the UK to all four mobile network operators ('MNOs') and other wireless network operators alongside a range of other products; for further information about [%] please see Appendix 1 at the end of this document.

As a provider of physical wireless infrastructure we do not have any direct input on the provisional findings for retail and wholesale competition. Regarding the other findings relevant to physical wireless infrastructure we are broadly in agreement with the CMA's conclusions and write up. However we believe the significant impacts on the infrastructure layer, which are currently not detailed in the provisional findings, should be included in the CMA's final report.

1. Improving Network Quality

We agree with the CMA assessment that the commitment to deploy an enhanced 26k macro points of presence ('PoP') network is a positive outcome and a strong example of how mergers can lead to better outcomes for consumers, businesses and wider society. [%].

2. Infrastructure Layer Considerations

With reference to our previous submissions, [%] is concerned that the CMA has not noted the significant impact the merger will have on the physical wireless infrastructure layer, specifically:
