## ROAD TRAFFIC

### **The Road Sensors Speed Measuring and the Light Signals (Detection of Offences) Devices Approval (No. 2) 2004**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 20(4) and (5) of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988 (a) (Speeding offences etc: admissibility of certain evidence) and having prescribed for the purposes of section 20 of that Act a device:

- (i) designed or adapted for recording a measurement of the speed of motor vehicles activated by means of sensors or cables on or near the surface of the highway (b), and
- (ii) designed or adapted for recording by photographic or other image recording means the position of motor vehicles in relation to light signals (c),

hereby approves as from 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2004 for the purpose of detection of offences specified in section 20(2)(a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) of that Act the device known as **RedSpeed** manufactured by Redspeed International Ltd of Kidderminster, Worcestershire.
