



Legislation review with developments in food and feed law

September 2024

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Summary

This is a summary of UK legislation in food and feed law and related scientific and regulatory issues for the period from 1 April to 30 September 2024. Other relevant technical updates are listed thereafter.

Primary GB legislation.

Secondary GB legislation

<u>The Cosmetic Products (Restriction of Chemical Substances) Regulations 2024</u> provide for the restriction in use of BHT in cosmetic products.

<u>The Meat Preparations (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2024</u> amend in Wales the provisions for import of meat preparations from 3rd countries. Also available in <u>Welsh.</u>

<u>The Official Controls (Extension of Transitional Periods) (Amendment) Regulations 2024</u> make a number of provisions, including amending the import conditions for meat preparations from 3rd countries and amend the transitional staging period.

The Alcohol (Minimum Pricing) (Scotland) Act 2012 (Continuation) Order 2024 allows for the continuation of minimum alcohol pricing in Scotland, an is accompanied by The Alcohol (Minimum Price per Unit) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2024 setting a revised minimum price.

The Food Additives and Novel Foods (Authorisations and Miscellaneous Amendments) and Food Flavourings (Removal of Authorisations) (England Regulations 2024 make a number of amendments to the stated legislation, including setting maximum limits for ethylene oxide in food additives. The Windsor Framework (Retail Movement Scheme: Plant and Animal Health) (Amendment etc.)
Regulations 2024 implement and make amendments to the Windsor framework with respect to movement of certain goods from Great Britain to Northern Ireland.

The Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023 (Commencement No. 2 and Saving Provisions) (Revocation) Regulations 2024 revoke the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023 (Commencement No. 2 and Saving Provisions) Regulations 2024 and therefore section 6 of the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023 (c. 28) will not longer come into force on the 1st October 2024.
