JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of direct race/nationality discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of breach of contract in relation to notice pay is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of breach of contract in relation to car hire/car leasing is not well-founded and is dismissed.

- 4. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The employer's contract claim is well-founded and succeeds. Remedy shall be determined at a separate hearing if required.
