

# <u>Application to register a standard bus service in England and Wales: Supplementary Form – request for short notice</u>

#### **About this form**

You should use this form with the registration form <u>PSV350</u> or the cancellation and changes form <u>PSV355</u> in all cases where the period of notice is less than the required notice period (42 days in England or 56 days in Wales).

You should provide a letter of support from the local authority. This will be taken into account with your application.

If you wish to vary the timetable for all or part of the week which includes 24 December, Christmas Day, Good Friday or any bank holiday, a formal variation is not required. You must serve a notice of intent on the Traffic Commissioner 21 days before the variation is to take effect. Do not send to the Office of the Traffic Commissioner on its own.
