### Publication\_Number

Agency related field that tracks any documents or information that we publish.

### UKPRN

The UK Register of Learning Providers (UKRLP) is a 'one-stop' portal for government departments, agencies, learners and employers to share key information about learning providers. The UKRLP allows providers to update their information in one place and share this across agencies such as the Skills Funding Agency, the Higher Education Funding Council for England (HEFCE) and UCAS.

We use the UK Provider Register Number (UKPRN), which is verified by UKRLP as part of our due diligence processes ahead of contracting with a provider.

Each learning provider has a unique UKPRN, which must be used to submit data to us via the Individualised Learner Record.

### Provider\_Name

The Provider name is the name of the legal entity with whom we will enter into a contract. The provider name is verified by us using Companies House, UKRLP and audited accounts information provided by the provider.

There are a small number of providers not included in this publication as we are still finalising their final 2012/13 position.

## **Funding\_Line**

In 2012/13 the Adult Skills Budget is made up of: adult Apprenticeships; other workplace learning; classroom learning; Additional Learning Support; and Formal First Step. Discretionary Learner Support is also included in the Adult Skills total.

In 2012/13 Community Learning is made up of: Personal and Community Development Learning; Family, English, Maths and Language (previously known as Family Literacy, Language and Numeracy); Wider Family Learning; and Neighbourhood Learning in Deprived Communities.

In 2012/13 16-18 Apprenticeships are funded by the Education Funding Agency and managed by us. This funding is shown separately to Adult Skills and Community Learning.

## **Value\_Type**

The value of activity providers have earned is worked out by us using their verified Individualised Learner Record data. We then compare those earnings to the providers' contract value and apply our published performance management rules to calculate the final value of activity that we fund (the funded value).

## **Value**

This is the delivered or funded value shown in pounds (£).

Due to contract system rounding the published values may be different to final funded and delivered values.
