

Youth Engagement Statistics for Northern Ireland 2023/24



Cases overall



2,015 young people came into formal contact with the criminal justice system in **3,356 cases.**

35.4% deemed suitable for resolution through Youth Engagement (YE).



Youth Engagement Clinics

Median time taken for cases to complete the Youth Engagment process



In cases that resulted in a restorative caution, there was some victim involvement or input in 60.2% of cases.

Legal advice or representation was **declined** in **75.6%** of cases though it was offered to all young people.



98.9% of young people who participated in clinics stated it 'helped them understand the choices available to them'.

Compared to the previous year, the number of young people assessed as suitable for youth engagement dropped by 8%. Youth Conferences as a percentage of all outcomes also dropped by 1.8 percentage points.
