Question 3

Our records begin from 2012, so we are unable to support your request to identify the longest sentence 'in the history of the SFO'. We can confirm that our longest sentence since our records began was in 2018. A 16-year sentence was handed down to Osman Shahenshah - 6 years jail for one count of fraud, contrary to section 1 of the Fraud Act 2006; 6 years concurrent for one count of money laundering, contrary to section 329 of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002; and 4 years concurrent for one count of money laundering, contrary to section 328 of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002.
