



# Inspection of HMP Hull



Inspectors visited this prison in June and July 2024.



We wanted to find out if things were better, the same or worse for prisoners since we last visited in 2021.



### We did this by:

- looking around the prison
- asking prisoners and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to prisoners
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

### What did we find?



Prisoners felt quite safe. There was less violence than the last time we visited, but more prisoners were using drugs.

We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



Most prisoners said staff treated them well. Some cells were crowded and some were damp. We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners needed more time out of their cells. There were not enough places in education, work and training. Teaching was poor.

We gave the prison 1 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners got some good help to get ready to leave HMP Hull.

We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.

### What should the prison do?



We want the governor to read our inspection report. You can find the report in the prison library.

We want the governor to make a plan. The plan should tell us how they will fix the problems at HMP Hull and make things better for prisoners.

## What do we want to happen?




We want the prison to do more to stop prisoners getting drugs they should not have.



We want teaching to be better. We want more prisoners to go to education, skills and work.



We want prisoners to have more time out of their cells. We want cells to be less cramped.



We want the prison to do more to stop prisoners from harming themselves.



We want fewer men to be homeless when they leave HMP Hull. We want prisoners to have somewhere safe to stay.



We want all prisoners to be treated fairly. We want prisoners who don't speak English and disabled prisoners to get the help they need.




We want prisoners to have more help with reading. We want the prison to do more to get prisoners interested in reading.



We want prisoners to have more to do to stop them being bored, like pool and table tennis.
