

THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2016

The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Exercise of Functions) (Fine Grinding Ltd) Direction 2024

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(b) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016¹, gives the following Direction.

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Exercise of Functions) (Fine Grinding Ltd) Direction 2024 and comes into force on 21 November 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction-

“the 2016 Regulations” means the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016;

“operator” means Fine Grinding Ltd;

“premises” means the premises listed in Schedule 1; and

“relevant activity” means the activity listed in Schedule 2 carried out at the premises.

Exercise of functions

3. From the date this Direction comes into force and until such time as it is withdrawn, the relevant activities exercisable under the 2016 Regulations by the Environment Agency in respect of the operator at the premises are exercisable by Derbyshire Dales District Council.
