The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Exercise of Functions) (Tudor Griffiths Limited) Direction 2024

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(a) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016¹, gives the following Direction.

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Exercise of Functions) (Tudor Griffiths Limited) Direction 2024 and comes into force on 21 November 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction-

"the 2016 Regulations" means the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016;

"operator" means Tudor Griffiths Limited;

"premises" means the premises in Schedule 1;

"relevant activity" means the activity in Schedule 2 carried out at the premises.

Exercise of functions

3. From the date this Direction comes into force until such time as it is withdrawn, the functions in relation to the relevant activity under the 2016 Regulations exercisable by Shropshire Council in respect of the operator at the premises are exercisable by the Environment Agency.
