The British Embassy Prague presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic and has the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic for the Promotion and Protection of Investments with Protocol done at Prague on 10 July 1990 with an amending Exchange of Notes done at Prague on 23 August 1991 and 24 October 1991 ("the Agreement").

Further to discussions which have taken place between the Embassy and the Ministry on behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland ("the United Kingdom") and the Government of the Czech Republic (together, "the Parties"), the Embassy has the honour to propose the following:

1. The Parties agree to hereby expressly terminate the Agreement;
and
2. Notwithstanding the third sentence of Article 14 of the Agreement, following the termination of the Agreement, the provisions of the Agreement shall cease to have effect in respect of investments made while the Agreement was in force.

If the aforementioned proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Czech Republic, the Embassy has further the honour to propose that this Note together with the Note of the Czech Republic in reply shall constitute the Agreement between the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Czech Republic on Termination of the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic for

the Promotion and Protection of Investments with Protocol done at Prague on 10 July 1990 with an amending Exchange of Notes done at Prague on 23 August 1991 and 24 October 1991 ("the Termination Agreement").

Each of the Parties shall notify the other in writing, through diplomatic channels, of the completion of the procedures required by its law for the entry into force of the Termination Agreement. The Termination Agreement shall enter into force on the first day of the month following the date of receipt of the later notification.

The British Embassy Prague avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic the assurances of its highest consideration.
