Any person found guilty of such an offence is liable, on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or to both. Regarding other wildlife legislation, we will look to provisions in the Fraud Act 2006 (as amended) in respect of applicants making any false representations.
- Natural England or the Secretary of State can modify or revoke at any time any licence that
 is issued, but this will not be done unless there is good reason for doing so. Any licence
 that is issued is likely to be revoked immediately if it discovered that false information has
 been provided that resulted in the issue of a licence.
