DECLARATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: JAPAN THE TRADE IN ANIMALS AND RELATED PRODUCTS REGULATIONS 2011 (SI 2011/1197)

The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs has reasonable grounds for suspecting the existence of lumpy skin disease in Japan, such that certain products originating and dispatched from Japan are liable to pose risk to animal health.

Under regulation 29(1) of the Trade in Animals and Related Products Regulations 2011¹, the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs declares the following special measures to be necessary in England in order to contain the risk to animal health:

Suspension of entry into England

- **1.** Subject to paragraph 2, entry into England is suspended for hides and skins of bovine animals originating or dispatched from Japan.
- **2.** The restrictions in paragraph 1 do not apply if the hides and skins have been subjected to any of the following treatments–
 - a. dry-salted or wet-salted for a period of at least 14 days prior to dispatch;
 - b. salted for a period of at least 7 days in sea salt with the addition of 2% of sodium carbonate; or
 - c. dried for a period of at least 42 days at a temperature of at least 20°C.
- **3.** Subject to paragraph 4, entry into England is suspended for animal byproducts of bovine animals originating or dispatched from Japan.
- 4. The restrictions in paragraph 3 do not apply
 - a. if the animal by-products have undergone heat treatment to a minimum internal temperature of 65°C for at least thirty minutes; or
 - b. to the following animal by-products
 - i. casings;
 - ii. gelatine;
 - iii. collagen;
 - iv. tallow;
 - v. hooves;
 - vi. horns;

Interpretation

- 5. In this declaration
 - a. "animal by-products" means entire bodies or parts of animals, products of animal origin or other products obtained from animals, which are not intended for human consumption, excluding germinal products and hides and skins;
 - b. "hides and skins" means all cutaneous and subcutaneous tissues.

Coming into force and duration of the special measures

6. The special measures in this Declaration apply from the beginning of the day after the day on which this Declaration is made until this Declaration is revoked or amended by a further declaration.
