## **JUDGMENT**

The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is :-

- 1. The complaint of direct disability discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of discrimination arising from disability is well-founded and succeeds.
- 3. The complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments is well-founded and succeeds.
- 4. The respondent must pay to the claimant a total sum of £6,832.44 being the sum of £6000 compensation for injury to feelings together with interest in the sum of £832.44. The claimant did not prove any other heads of loss.
