THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2016

The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Exercise of Functions) (Linston Limited) Direction 2019

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(b) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016^(a), gives the following direction.

Citation and commencement

1. This direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Exercise of Functions) (Linston Limited) Direction 2019 and comes into force on the day after it is made.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this direction—

“the 2016 Regulations” means the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 as amended;

“operator” means Linston Ltd;

“premises” means the premises listed in Schedule 1;

“relevant activity” means the storage, treatment and disposal of any of the wastes listed in Schedule 2 carried out at the premises.

(2) In Schedule 2 a reference to a waste code is a reference to the corresponding code in the list of waste established by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC replacing Decision 94/3/EC establishing a list of waste pursuant to Article 1(a) of Council Directive 75/442/EEC on waste and Council Decision 94/941/EC establishing a list of hazardous waste pursuant to Article 1(4) of Council Directive 91/676/EEC on hazardous waste, as amended.

Exercise of functions

3. From the date this direction comes into force until 14 November 2024 or earlier revocation, the functions in relation to the relevant activity under the 2016 Regulations by the Environment Agency in respect of the operator at the premises are exercisable by Derbyshire Dales District Council.

This direction directs the Derbyshire Dales District Council to exercise functions under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 (S.I. 2016/1154) in relation to the relevant activity in Schedule 2 carried on at the premises listed in Schedule 1.
