JUDGMENT ON RECONSIDERATION

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:

1. It is in the interests of justice to extend to 7 February 2024 the time within which for the claimant to apply for reconsideration of the Judgment promulgated on 15 January 2024 ('the Judgment').
2. It is not in the interests of justice for the Judgment to be varied or revoked.
3. Accordingly, the claimant's reconsideration application dated 7 February 2024 is refused.
4. In the alternative, the claimant's application for a Preparation Time Order to be made against the respondent is refused.
