## JUDGMENT ON REMEDY

The unanimous decision of the Tribunal is as follows:

1. The claimant is awarded compensation in the total sum of £29,187, as follows:

(a)	Financial loss	£10,965
(b)	Interest on financial loss	£944
(c)	Injury to feelings	£14,825
(d)	Interest on the above	£2,453

2. Judgment is not to be enforced without the leave of the Tribunal pending the respondent's appeal against the decision on liability. However, if a decision is made by the Employment Appeal Tribunal under Rule 3(7) of the Employment Appeal Tribunal Rules of Procedure that the notice of appeal discloses no reasonable grounds for bringing the appeal, the Judgment may be enforced without further leave of the Tribunal.
