- 2) This revocation takes effect from 14.00 on 19 December 2024, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference SW5531828948 declared on 10 December 2024, which had replaced the original declaration of a protection and surveillance zone dated 17 November 2024.
