- 1) The Secretary of State makes this declaration to revoke the surveillance zone that was declared at 11:30 on 26 January 2025 in accordance with articles 4(1)(e) and 36(3) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No. 2) Order 2006¹.
- 2) This revocation takes effect from 15.45 on 5 February 2025, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference TA0349746143 declared on 26 January 2025, which had replaced the original declaration of a protection and surveillance zone dated 28 December 2024.
