JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgement of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The complaint of direct disability discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of disability related discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of constructive unfair dismissal discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability is not well founded and is dismissed.

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5. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from wages by failing to pay the claimant the contractual amount of his wages due for the two week period prior to 4 May 2023 and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1341.94, beinfg the total gross sum deducted.
