Check the standard of health and social care services in England. They are called the **CQC** for short.



The Department of Health and Social Care had a **consultation in** 2024.

A **consultation** is when we ask questions to find out what people think about making a change.

Our consultation was open to

- ✓ the public
- ✓ providers of checked activities we call these regulated activities



We had **189 replies** to our questions.

We had extra comments by email too.



We had **33 easy read replies** to our questions.

Our main question was asking about our rules that end in **March 2025.**



We want to review the rules every **5 years** instead of having an end date.


What else we wanted to find out

What we found out



 There was good support to review the rules every 5 years instead of having an end date.



 Most people agreed that treatment at sporting events and cultural activities should be checked. But we should ask more questions before making the change.



3. There was good support to change what happens with restraint in mental health units. But we should ask more questions before making the change.

What happens next



We want the government to pass a law that means our rules are reviewed every 5 years.



We decided that 2 of our proposals on restraint and segregation and treatment at sporting and cultural events need more work before we can make them happen.

We will spend more time on policy before we make these changes.
