FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: UPDATING CROWN AND ROYAL CYPHER.

We refer to your email dated 30th August 2024 to the Ministry of Defence Police (MDP), which was acknowledged on 2nd September 2024.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

How much has the MoD Police spent so far on updating the crown and royal cypher in its badges, signage, printed materials, and electronic media from St. Edward's Crown and the Queen's cypher to the Tudor Crown and King's cypher as a result of the accession of King Charles in 2022?

How much has been budgeted to complete this update?

And when is it expected that the Tudor Crown will have fully replaced St. Edward's Crown?

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that the MDP do hold information in scope of your request.

How much has the MoD Police spent so far on updating the crown and royal cypher in its badges, signage, printed materials, and electronic media from St. Edward's Crown and the Queen's cypher to the Tudor Crown and King's cypher as a result of the accession of King Charles in 2022?

How much has been budgeted to complete this update?
