JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules – Rule 22

1. The claim was issued in the Central London Employment Tribunals on 12 April 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with Rule 22 of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules.
2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £6,171.28 gross (comprising £3,011.52 pay in lieu of notice, £184.01 accrued holiday pay and £2,975.75 wages for February 2024) LESS a deduction of £1,500 already paid by the respondent.
4. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £4,517.28.
