# JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent made unauthorised deductions from wages by failing to pay the Claimant in respect of days worked between 21 February 2024 and 3 March 2024. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £920.16 being the total gross sum which was deducted.
2. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay on termination of employment, under regulation 14 Working Time Regulations 1998, is not well founded. It is dismissed.
3. The Respondent was in breach of contract by dismissing the Claimant without notice. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant damages of £1,833, being the gross sum due.
