Please can you release all and any communication in regards to Operation: London Bridge. In particular any communication from the 6th September, until after the State Funeral.

I would be particularly interested in seeing how the initial announcement was made, and if any lessons learned exercises took place, what the results were.

Please feel free to redact any personal information.

We have requested clarification and you have responded:

How the initial announcement was made? - To whom?

- I would like to know how the civil servants were notified, particularly any communications before 6:30 on the 8th September.

Any lessons learned exercises took place, what the results were - exactly in relation to what, the funeral ceremony?

- Lessons learned from the London events, so lying in state and the funeral.
